# 1. Medicaid Budget Cuts

- Discussion on proposed cuts to Medicaid and SNAP.
  - These changes may not go into effect until 2027.
  - Work requirements for eligibility could begin as early as January.
- Reimbursement rates for states are expected to be reduced by nearly 50%.
  - o Potential for reimbursement caps was discussed.
  - o There are concerns about the impact on vulnerable populations.
  - Action: Paula will forward an article to Andria outlining the current implications.
- Waiver reforms have been postponed, originally planned for 2026.

- HHS will be posting written comments for public response on their website.
- Committee discussed whether to prepare a response when available.

## 2. Transportation Issues with SEATS (Led by Ernie Geiger)

- The University of Iowa opened a new orthopedic hospital in North Liberty.
  - SEATS currently only provides service at 7am, 11am, and 5pm.
  - o Inadequate service has forced individuals (like Ernie) to rely on Uber.
  - SEATS claims it cannot serve North Liberty due to lack of a contract.
